## ABSTRACT:

Though relatively infrequent, animal bites in the head and neck region can produce potentially serious pathologic conditions that must be judiciously addressed. Facial wound caused by animal attack require proper wound management. Moreover, the evaluation and treatment plan of facial wounds must always include the possibility of rabies. BECAUSE OF ITS INFREQUENT OCCURRENCE IN HUMANS, MANY CLINICIANS may not be cognizant of the current antirabies prophylaxis. So, this study was undertaken to elucidate a recommended protocol for rabies control and the treatment of associated bites and scratch wounds.
